

IN THE MATTER OF RULES OF COURT RELATIVE TO FORFEITURE OF COLLATERAL IN LIEU OF APPEARANCE IN SUITABLE TYPES OF MISDEMEANOR CASES

U.S. DISTRICT COURT W.D.N.Y. - BUFFALO

Pursuant to the provisions of Rule 58(d)(1), Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure and Local Rule 58.3 of the Local Rules of Criminal Procedure for the Western District of New York,

IT IS ORDERED

That the following rules relative to the forfeiture of collateral in lieu of appearance in suitable types of misdemeanor cases as set forth herein be and hereby are adopted as a Rule of the District Court of the United States for the Western District of New York.

- 1. The Rules of the Court and schedules relative to the Forfeiture of Collateral filed on February 3, 1995, and any amendments thereto now in force and effect, are hereby repealed and superseded by this Order and the schedule of payments attached hereto.
- 2. For misdemeanor and petty offenses listed herein, whether originating under the applicable federal statute or regulations or under applicable State statute by virtue of the Assimilated Crimes Act (18 U.S.C. § 13) occurring within the territorial jurisdiction of the United States Magistrates Judges, including areas within the boundaries of the United States military installations, public buildings and grounds and national forests, and property under the charge and control of the Veterans Administration or of the Postal Service, the person so charged may, in lieu of appearance, post collateral in the amount indicated for the offense, waive appearance before a United States Magistrate Judge, and consent to the forfeiture of

collateral. The posting of said collateral shall signify that the offender does not contest the charge nor request a hearing before the designated United States Magistrate Judge.

- 3. If the collateral is forfeited, such action shall be tantamount to a finding of guilt. Either the Clerk or Magistrate Judge shall certify the record of any conviction of a traffic violation as required by the applicable State statute to the proper authority.
- 4. Whenever a check is returned to the Clerk as uncollectible for any reason within the control of the payer, the offense for which the collateral was posted shall become a mandatory appearance offense, and shall be referred immediately to the appropriate Magistrate Judge for a mandatory hearing.
- 5. The offenses for which collateral may be posted in lieu of appearance by the person charged with said offense are set forth in the schedules attached hereto.

- (b) Watercraft;
- (c) Over-snow vehicles:
- (d) Limited administrative use by Forest Service;
- (e) Use of any fire, military, emergency, or law enforcement vehicle for emergency purposes;
- (f) Authorized use of any combat or combat support vehicle for national defense purposes;
- (g) Law enforcement response to violations of law, including pursuit;
- (h) Motor vehicle use that is specifically authorized under a written authorization issued under Federal law or regulations; and

POSTAL REGULATIONS 39 CFR § 232.1 SCHEDULE OF OFFENSES AND PENALTIES

(a) These rules and regulations apply to all real property under the charge and control of the Postal Service, to all tenant agencies, and to all persons entering in or on such property. Violations of these rules and regulations are punishable by a fine of not more than \$50.00 or by imprisonment of not more than thirty (30) days or both.
