ADMINISTRATIVE
ORDER

Whereas it has come to the attention of the Court that there is a current emergency concerning the availability of parking for jurors who drive to the United States Courthouse in Rochester, and grand jurors have, through their foreman, reported that the current \$4.00 per day reimbursement for parking is inadequate to compensate jurors for the cost of parking in such proximity to that Courthouse as is consistent with their health and safety, accordingly


IT IS ORDERED that effective immediately as to all jury payments not yet processed, and effective until further order of the Court, the Clerk shall reimburse all jurors who incur parking costs in connection with their service at the Rochester Courthouse at the flat rate of \$7.00 per day, rather than \$4.00 per day.

This order shall apply only to jurors reporting for duty in Rochester.

It appears adequate parking is available to jurors reporting for duty in Buffalo with even additional space to be made available upon completion of a parking garage adjacent to the Courthouse now under construction. If parking rates

increase in Buffalo, the matter will be reviewed at that time.
