### What is Pay.gov?

Pay.gov is a secure Government website that allows you to submit payments for your criminal debt electronically.

Pay.gov is managed by the Department of the Treasury, Financial Management Services.

Pay.gov is a convenient and fast way to make secure Online payments to Federal Agencies.

#### **Accepted Payment Methods:**

Bank Account (ACH)

Debit Card

 Credit Cards are NOT accepted for Criminal Debt Payments, ONLY DEBIT.

### How Do I Pay Criminal Debt Online using Pay.gov?

- 1. Have your Case & Defendant Number from either your U.S. Probation Officer, your monthly payment coupon/statement (CCAM Number) or contact the Finance Department at (716)551-1730.
- 2. Have your debit card or bank account information available.
- 3. Using your computer or Internet accessible device visit Pay.gov via this link: https://Pay.gov/public/form/start/1045967523
- 4. From the New York Western, Criminal Debt Payment Page screen, click the box titled Continue to the Form
- 5. Complete the form:
  - Enter defendant's name as it appears on the judgment.
  - Enter the case and defendant's number using the CCAM number from your payment coupon/statement. The last three digits make up the defendant number.
  - Enter the Payer Information, click enter.
  - Enter the Payment Method (Debit Card or Bank Account (ACH)), review and submit.
  - Review information, check the authorization and disclosure box, click "Submit Payment".
  - Upon completion of a successful payment, you will receive a payment submitted confirmation email.
